

How to Register to Take the USMLE Step 1 Exam

In order to apply to take USMLE Step 1, go to <https://apps.nbme.org/ciw2/prod/jsp/login.jsp>
Follow these instructions. You will find them on the website as well:

- Apply for USMLE Step 1, Step 2 CK and/or Step 2 CS.
- Print Scheduling Permit for Step 1, Step 2 CK and/or Step 2 CS
- Print Score Report for Step 1, Step 2 CK and/or Step 2 CS
- Request score documents, certificates and/or confirmation letters.
- Check the status of your registration and document request history.
- Schedule an appointment for Step 2 CS.
- Check and update your personal information (e.g., name, address).
- Print Step 1 and Step 2 CK Eligibility Period Extension Form.
- Print Score Recheck Form.

When you print your application, attach your picture but DON'T SIGN THE APPLICATION until you bring it to Burke or Dr. London. They must witness your signature before putting the school seal on the application. Bonnie sends out the applications once a week on Wednesdays. The USMLE/NBME emails you throughout the process prompting the next step. After the USMLE/NBME receives the paper application, Mary Jean electronically verifies applications on Wednesdays on the NBME website. If more than a week passes and you need to have your application verified (you'll receive an email from the NBME regarding this), email Mary Jean at Mary.Allen@sbumed.org and let her know.

Register in December for June exams. Long Island and New York City testing sites fill up quickly. Don't wait. The Class of 2014 must take the USMLE Step 1 by June 22nd.
