SBUH operates a wireless (Wi-Fi) network exclusively for patients and guests. Using your Wi-Fi-enabled laptop you can access many Internet resources (e-mail, web pages, etc.) from just about anywhere in the Hospital, as well as, many outpatient areas including patient rooms and visitor lounges*.

Is there a fee?

No, SBUH provides this service free of charge to patients and guests.

What do I need to connect?

A laptop (Windows or Mac) or PDA equipped with a Wi-Fi compliant (802.11b/g) wireless card.

Is it secure?

Wireless networks are not inherently secure. It is always a good idea to make sure you are on an SSL-encrypted webpage prior to sending/receiving confidential data.



Get Connected Now:



1. Start up your laptop and turn on the wireless card.
2. Your computer may automatically find the wireless network “sbuh”. If so, simply connect to this network and skip to step #5
3. If your computer does not automatically find this network, simply set your SSID or ESSID to “sbuh” (without the quotes & lower case) and set WEP encryption to None. You should also set the connection to Infrastructure Mode.
4. If you performed Step #3, please reboot your computer.
5. After you have connected, open your web-browser (Internet Explorer, Firefox, Safari, etc.).
6. Read the Terms and Conditions and click the “Accept & Connect” button.
