

## Driving Directions

Long Island State Veterans Home  
100 Patriots Road  
Stony Brook, NY 11790-3300

Take the Long Island Expressway (east/westbound) to exit 62 north - Nicolls Road. Proceed north on Nicolls Road for approximately 9 miles until you reach the FIRST entrance to the Stony Brook University - Health Sciences Drive.

Make a right turn on to Health Sciences Drive, and proceed 6/10 of a mile to Patriot's Road. Make a right turn on to Patriot's Road and drive down to the Long Island State Veterans Home. For visitor's parking make a right at the stop sign and your first left. For the East Pavilion, follow Patriots Road till the end.
