

Cardiovascular Computed Tomography (CCT) Interpretation  
Cardiac CT Scan Interpretation Criteria for Privileging

Initial Credential Requirement

- 1 - Documentation of coursework/training in physics of CT and radiation generation and exposure (total 5 hours training).
- 2 - Documentation of coursework/training in the use of iodinated contrast agents with treatment of adverse reactions (total 1 hour training).
- 3 - Documented mentored interpretation of 50 cases of CCT (mentor must be a Level 2 or 3 (preferred) qualified mentor physician) and documentation of additional 100 cases from teaching files, case studies, CDs/DVDs, or continued medical education (CME) courses.

OR

- 4- \*Documentation of American College of Cardiology (ACC) Level 2 or 3 Cardiovascular Computed Tomography (CCT) Training. \*Effective July 1, 2009 this will be required for all initial requests for this procedure.

Maintenance of Credentials

- 1 - Documentation of 50 CCT examinations reported each year.
- 2 - Documentation of twenty (20) hours of category I CME over 3 years in CCT.
